

WOODLAND WINTER FOX

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

CCX3177 Holiday Fox Medium Round Brush Detail Brush Liner Brush

COLORS

CMM 73 - Honeycomb

CMM 13 - Cinnamon Stick

CMM 15 - Mississippi

CMM 30 - Red Rock

CMM 67 - Snowflake

CMM 82 - Olive You

CMM 72 - Sahara

CMM 31 - Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Paint the face, tip of the tail, outside of the ears, and the chest with 3 coats of Sahara.
- 2. Use a small brush to paint the inside of the ears with 3 coats of Honeycomb.
- 3. Paint the rest of the head with 3 coats of Cinnamon Stick. When you get to the ears, sweep a liner brush with Cinnamon Stick up onto the back of the ear to help the ear blend with the body.
- 4. Paint the rest of the body with 3 coats of Cinnamon Stick except for the front paws.
- 5. Use a medium brush to paint in the top part of the hat with 3 coats of Red Rocks. We are going to leave the trim and ball of the hat unpainted. They'll be white and shiny after firing.
- 6. Use a small brush to paint the front paws with 3 coats of Mississippi Mud. Take a liner brush and load it with the Mississippi Mud and sweep it from the paws up the legs.
- 7. Fill in the scarf with 3 coats of Olive You.
- 8. Use a detail brush to apply 3 coats of Mississippi Mud to the eyes, and nose. Then apply a mouth with the liner brush.
- 9. Paint on the eyebrows with a liner brush and Cinnamon Stick.
- 10. Dip the handle of a small brush into Snowflake paint and tap the highlight on the eye.
- 11. Add a little water to Snowflake paint. Dip a medium brush into the paint and pull the bristle back to flick white spots to the top of the hat.

TIPS

- Three coats of paint will give you solid colors.
- You can cover the entire piece with the "snow" spots or just the hat.
