

WATERCOLOR FLOWERS FLOWER GARDEN PLANTER

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

MB1557 Textured Planters
Fan Brush
Liner Brush
Detail Brush
Small Brush
Pencil or Water-Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie
CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape
CMM 47 - Deep Sea
CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 29 - Grasshopper
CMM 66 - Pink Berry



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Water down Grasshopper with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 2. Use a small brush to apply the stems by pressing the brush into the grooves on the side of the planter. Use 2 coats of the watered-down Grasshopper paint, allowing the sections to overlap.
- 3. Use a detail brush to apply little flowers among the stems with 2 coats of the desired paint.
- 4. To apply centers to some of the flowers, dip the handle of a detail brush into the desired color, and tap it on the center of the flower.
- 5. Create the the blue dotted flowers by dipping the handle of the detail brush into Deep Sea and tapping it along to create the flowers.
- 6. Water down Banana Boat with 50% water and 50% paint.
- 7. Paint the inside of the planter with 2 coats of the watered-down Banana Boat using a fan brush.
- 8. Use a small brush to apply 2 coats of watered-down Banana Boat to the rim of the planter.

TIPS

- By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
- If desired, use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers.
